Thank you for taking an interest in joining us on our trip, following the Old Hume Hwy from Campbellfield to Albury. We will be driving as much of the original Hume Highway 31 as we can along the way.

This run is for likeminded people from various commercial vehicle clubs and or individuals to enjoy taking their older trucks for a run. The plan is to recapture the past and try to relive the old days where the trucks were louder, slower, the roads were a lot rougher, and the men were a lot tougher.

Our aim with run is to enjoy driving our trucks in a relaxed atmosphere with no strict guidelines. You can leave and re-joining the group at any time, stay in Albury or head home, its up to you.

We purely want to run the old route in a leisurely manner, share a few photos, stories and maybe some BS. You will have to organise your own means and accommodation with the exception of the Saturday night dinner in Albury Racing Club at 6pm for those who choose to attend.

We will be visiting to old forgotten towns that were bypassed a long time ago. As the highway from Campbellfield to Benalla was the first part of the freeway to get done.

NOTE: All entrants will be required to meet on Saturday 14th outside the Ford Factory in Sydney Road, Service road Campbellfield from 6am. We will be at the northern end (The Australian Mint) end of the service road.

Entrants are asked to enter via Barry Road, making sure you keep all the side roads and driveways clear at all times.

Look for the Haulin The Hume trailer. You will need to come to the trailer to receive your entry bag which will contain your itinerary and directions to allow you to find your way along the old Hume, as well as your meal pass for those who are attending the dinner if they have not already received them.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Please do not camp outside the Ford Factory the night prior, as this is the service road and Ford need full access.

Please note that ALL trucks must be entered but if you come in a car no matter what age entry wont be required. Entry is only required for Trucks driven on the run so any tow vehicles don't need to be entered. We have a cut off of 25 years or OLDER so anyone wanting to bring their late model truck with a set of trailers will not be encouraged to join us.

THIS RUN IS ONLY OPEN TO OLDER VEHICLES.

Special THANK YOU to Winton Raceway for their support.
Winton Raceway will be our lunch break allowing us to use their facilities. They will also have their catering kiosks open for us to purchase our lunch there.

Trucks will enter via the side road (it will be signed) and cars are to proceed to the next entry (also signed)

We can sit back and have a break or a walk around and see all the other trucks, catch up with some old friends and tell some stories.

NOTE: There will be some car racing on during the time we are Winton as its also V8 Drive Day.

After Winton Raceway we will follow the Old Hume Highway to Wodonga and Albury. We hope you have a great time reliving old memories.

INDEMNITY CLAUSE

- 1. By signing this form, the entrant acknowledges and agrees they will have no claim whatsoever against the Organisers or any of the committee thereof or against any other person associated with the organisations of the "Crawlin the Hume" (of whom are hereafter "The Organisers")
- a) Whether such claims shall arise out of personal injury or property damage.
- b) Weather caused or contributed by act or omission of the organisers and,
- c) Whether occurring prior to, or during, or after the Crawlin the Hume.
- 2. The entrant or participants also agrees that he/she will indemnify the organisers against any claim as aforesaid which might be made by the drivers/passengers in the entrant/participants vehicle, against the organisers.
- 3. I acknowledge that I have read, understood and accepted the rules and conditions of entry to Crawlin the Hume.

To assist with the smooth running of the even the following RULES and CONDITIONS have been set.

- a) Only those commercial motor vehicles built on or before the 31st of Dec 1991 are eligible to enter.
- b) All vehicles must be roadworthy, have current registration labels or permits affixed to the vehicles and drivers must be a holder of a current driver's license applicable with the vehicles being driven.
- c) No vehicle will be permitted to run of trade plates.
- d) No substitution shall be made with the knowledge and written approval of the Entries Director and the payment of such fees as the committee may set.
- e) All entrants/participants will observe the current road laws and speed limits on the route.
- f) All entrants and passengers will conduct themselves in an orderly manner. Entrants and passengers are subject the directions and control in all things of the event's organisers, their agents and officials.
- g) Entrants/passengers conduction in a dangerous manner ore in a dangerous manner likely to bring Crawlin the Hume and its organisers into disrepute shall be disqualified immediately.
- h) The organiser reserves the right to terminate any entry at any time for any reason.
- i) The closing date for entries to Crawling the Hume is 1st April 2018.
- j) Entrants hereby authorise the organisers to photograph, film or reproduce in any medium the entrants motor vehicle used in the event and any other aspect of the event, and hereby acknowledge that the organisers shall have the free and unrestricted right to use entrant's names and or such reproductions in the advertising and promotion of the event and of future events.
- k) Please note that the current legislation does not allow passengers to be carried on the trays or utilities.
- The indemnity clause must be signed by the owners/entrant of the motor vehicles and returned with your entry form.
